ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- A Bachelor's degree from Universiti Utara Malaysia or any other institutions of higher learning recognized by the University Senate with a CGPA of at least 3.00;

and

- Fulfill the English language requirement

OR

- A Bachelor's degree from Universiti Utara Malaysia or any other institutions of higher learning recognized by the University Senate with a CGPA of at least 2.75; and
- At least two (2) years of relevant working experience or a good score on the Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT)/ Graduate Record Examination (GRE);

and

- Fulfill the English language requirement

OR

- A diploma from any Institution of higher learning recognized by the University Senate with at least ten (10) years of relevant work experience and aged 35 years or older;

and

- Fulfill the English language requirement
