- A Bachelor's degree from UUM or any other IHLs recognized by the University Senate with a CGPA of at least 3.00, and

OR

- A Bachelor's degree from UUM or any other IHLs recognized by the University Senate with a CGPA of at least 2.75, and
- At least two years of relevant working experience, or a good score on the GMAT test/GRE, and
- Fulfill English language requirement

OR

- A Diploma from any IHL recognized by the University Senate with at least ten years of relevant work experience and aged 35 years or older, and
- Fulfill English language requirement.
